PRESS RELEASE APPROVAL TO OPERATE

Due to the internal technical/Data issues, the Dept. of Marine & Ports is unable to process Online/Walk-in payments. This has caused a system wide shut down which the IT department is currently working to resolve. This has affected registrations of all boats, moorings, pylons and floating docks.

The registration expiration date has now been extended to **Friday June 17, 2022**.

For the 2022/2023 registration period, all new boats and boats that were not registered last year but were looking to be licenced, can attend the Boats and Mooring Section in Paget. Due to this unfortunate circumstance, you will be permitted to operate. You will be provided a **'Temporarily Approval to Operate'** letter which you will keep onboard your boat.

Once the internal issue has been resolved, a press release will be issued to update the boating public. There after you are required to attend the Boats and Moorings Section to settle your account.
